JOSEPH SHINER has been a regular performer with Outcry since the ensemble was formed. He is the recipient the Hattori Foundation Senior Award; the Making Music Philip and Dorothy Green Award for Young Concert Artists; the Worshipful Company of Musicians' Prince's Prize and the Royal Academy of Music's Buffet Crampon Clarinet Prize. He made his solo debut with the Cambridge University Symphony Orchestra at St. John's Smith Square in 2011, and is currently a selected artist for the City Music Foundation.

He gives recitals at UK music clubs and festivals, including the Two Moors and Three Choirs Festivals. He also has enjoyed collaborations with the Endellion and Alauda Quartets, and is a founding member of the wind chamber group 'Magnard Ensemble', which hold a Chamber Music fellowship and the inaugural Open Academy/Wigmore Hall ensemble fellowship at the Royal Academy of Music for the 2014-15 season. In 2012 Joseph accepted a Contemporary Ensemble fellowship at the Atlantic Music Festival, Maine, during which he premiered 38 new works. 2015 will see him premiering new works by Ian Morgan-Williams and Freya Waley-Cohen.

Joseph read Music at Gonville and Caius College, Cambridge, where he graduated with First Class honours, before moving on to postgraduate study with Angela Malsbury, Mark van de Wiel and Chi-Yu Mo at the Royal Academy of Music, graduating with the DipRAM. Joseph currently studies privately in Paris with Patrick Messina, principal clarinet of Orchestre National de France.

KATE WHITLEY is composer, pianist, and producer who is a 2014 Borletti Buitoni Trust Special Award Winner (piano, composition) and received a 2013 Sky Academy Futures Fund Bursary for her work in bringing classical music out of the concert hall and into new contexts. She was 2013-4 Music Fellow at Rambert Dance Company, and 2015 New Music Programmer at Kettles Yard Art Gallery.



She is the founder and Artistic Director, with conductor Christopher Stark, of The Multi-Story Orchestra, which began with a critically acclaimed performance of Stravinsky's *The Rite of Spring* in a disused multi-storey Car Park in Peckham to an audience of more than 1500 people. *Multi-Story* now performs in the Car Park every summer as well as taking the orchestra around local schools in a Tour Bus and running choir projects. Kate's own pieces *Wishes Lies and Dreams* (2013) and *Alive* (2014) have been performed in the Car Park by amassed choirs from local schools and community groups.
